Directions

Before the Hunt print all the clues and cut them at the dotted lines. In the Master sheet you will find suggested locations where to hide all the clues. In 4th JULY SCAVENGER HUNT the first clue is for a LIBERTY BELL; we suggest hiding A SMALL BELL and NEXT CLUE under the doormat near the doorbell. It might be a good idea to *not* hide the clue in "plain sight" to prevent the participants from accidentally spotting the clue before it's time to find it.

HAND THE CLUE 1 to the participants.

The Items you will need for this hunt:

Liberty Bell: Any small bells will suffice.

Uncle Sam: Cut out picture in magazine, buy, or draw Uncle Sam.

Fireworks: Use sparklers or any unopened and safe fireworks you plan to use later.

American Flag: Use small flags.

Clue 1

Clue 2



Gunpowder, explosions, loud noises, and sparks; you can see me at home or watch me at parks. My flames are enticing and thrilling to see. They remind you how great it is to be free.

Clue 3



Bearing thirteen stripes of red and white with 50 stars on blue, you'll find me flying throughout the town on houses in plain view. You pledge your allegiance to the republic and me, when you're at home, on land, or sea.

Clue 4

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Master Sheet

Clue 1: Liberty Bell - Hide the small bell under the doormat near the doorbell.

Clue 2: Uncle Sam - Place Uncle Sam on your bed.

Clue 3: Fireworks - Place them on the counter near the sink.

Clue 4: American Flag - Place it in the ground (without touching the ground) along the walkway leading to the front door.

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
